REPORT for NOV & DEC, 2016

It is hard to believe that we are leaving behind us another year and embarking on a new one. All things considered it was a good year of ministry as well as a busy one. We were privileged to have conducted 29 series of meetings (it would have been more but we had a total of 6 cancellations) and 9 1-day meetings. We praise the Lord for the souls that trusted Christ and for believers who were encouraged and strengthened in the Word.

Ministry Update: For 2017, we have scheduled 24 weeks of meetings, a few 1-day meetings with several weeks still open in Feb, Aug, Nov and Dec. I begin with a New Year's Watchnight service and Sunday services here in SC followed by a 2-week mission trip to Peru leaving on January 12th. Please pray for safety and souls. In March, we head out for our spring meetings in NC, GA, MS, TX, KS, MT, SK (in Canada), & CA before arriving back home in July.

Medical Update: Barb had her surgery on December 8th. It turned out to be much more extensive than originally thought but all went well. The procedure involved two different surgeons and both were encouraging in their reports to me. She came home the next day but is on a strict activity limit for a minimum of three weeks. Total recovery we are told will be several weeks. Joanna and I have been doing the cleaning, dishes, laundry, etc. Not doing all that bad a job, either, I might add. I do have a new appreciation though for the work of a homemaker! Hope all you men out there reading this will tell your wives how much you appreciate their many labors of love!

This morning (Dec. 21) I had an injection into both of my knees. The first one was extremely painful but only for about five minutes. The second was a "breeze". I could not believe the relief I received within 5 hours! I can walk without pain as well as getting up out of a chair without feeling like I'm going to fall. Praise the Lord! I only hope whatever they put into me lasts a long time. I am to see an orthopedic surgeon in January for an evaluation.

Misc.: My two new books that we mentioned last month are now at the printers and we are awaiting a proof copy before going to press. Hope to have them soon. Also, the first week of January I will be recording a new CD of music featuring the violin and bandura.
