Until it was all over, I had no idea how many folks were praying for the Lord to provide a helpmeet for me. Well, He answered their prayers...and mine! My grandson Samuel served as my Best Man. Ministry Update: By the time you receive and/or read this, Joan and I will have embarked on our first ministry trip together. A copy of our itinerary is on my recently updated website. I do want to share something from last fall that you will enjoy.
