REPORT for JANUARY 2024

Dear Friends,

Ministry Update: Where in the world did 2023 go? It just seemed to slip by almost unnoticed! But here we are one week into another new year. Welcome, 2024! It will be exciting to see what the Lord has for us this year. A lot has happened since our last letter, so let me try and briefly bring you up to date.

Of the fifteen weeks in the fall, twelve were spent in Pennsylvania, one in Connecticut, one in New York and one in Delaware. Most were in small churches, some extremely rural. It was good to be able to spend so much time in my home state. The Lord blessed the meetings as evidenced by the many comments made to me. During one of our meetings, a violent storm came up with 50-60 mph winds and torrential rain accompanied by almost terrifying lightning and thunder. Joan was lying in bed when suddenly a large branch broke off a nearby tree and came crashing through the skylight in the room just above her head! Then the rain poured in. What a night that was.

We are looking forward to a full schedule of meetings starting in February all the way through the end of June.

Missions Update: In March of this year, Joan and I will take our first mission trip together (my 57th) where we will be ministering in the Manila area of the Philippines in two churches and a Bible college. I am also beginning to make plans for a return trip to India in February 2025. With both of us going, we will need to raise some support, mostly to cover air fare. It will be my fourth time to visit that country.

Medical Update: Just after Thanksgiving I became ill again. I was able to preach a meeting in Delaware through Wednesday. After the evening service it was strongly suggested that I go to the ER. Once there, they kept me for the next three days suffering from Influenza Type A couple with asthma complications. While there the Lord gave me wonderful opportunities of ministry. Everyone who came in my room received gospel tract I wrote based on my time in the U.S. Navy. Early one morning, a male nurse came in and we got into a 20 minute or so conversation in which I was able to clearly present the gospel. Gave him some things to think about.

Motorhome Update: While I praise the Lord for the Winnebago Minnie Winnie, we found that, while it was fine for me as a single man, two adults living in it was like two robins trying to live in a hummingbird nest. That being said, the Lord has provided a larger Class A Coachman Encounter 37LS with only 40,000 miles.
